Enterprising Rural Families teaches people in rural family-based businesses the skills to think proactively, analyze critically, manage profitable enterprises, recognize potential, and act on opportunities with confidence.

Structure of the course ~



Enterprising Rural Families is designed to be completed in 26-weeks but can be taken over a six-month time period to allow for the busy lives of families running their businesses. The course is self-paced so a person can enroll at the beginning of any month. Divided into three parts, the course takes a participant through the stages from

Where are you? to Where do you want to go? to How will you get there?
